






# A message from Pastor Dave...

#### St Matthew Lutheran Church Council Meeting August 13, 2023

Call to Order: The August meeting of St Matthew was called to order by Jeff Hinrichs. Those present were Stu Gerdes, Pastor Dave, DaLana Rigby, Carolyn Dirks, Dave Titman, Trisha Lambert, Carolyn Tonn, Jeff Hinrichs, Nanci Paulsen and Diane Tuetken. **Devotions** were given by DaLana Rigby. **Minutes** were previously reviewed.

**Pastor's Report:** Pastor Dave announced the Pulpit Supply for 2023. DaMisha McFarlan Pollock will be Sept. 3rd, Riley Anderson-Reed Oct. 15th, Emily Ronsberg Oct 29<sup>th</sup> and Jim Reuter on Nov. 19<sup>th</sup>. WOW and Confirmation will be starting on September 13<sup>th</sup> with pizza and cake kickoff followed by worship. Pastor explained how the ELCA is handling the shortage of Pastors by equipping lay members of the congregation as Synodically Authorized Ministers. This is a one-year pilot program, where participants will attend four workshops in September and October covering topics such as sacramental ministry, preaching, pastoral care and worship planning.

**Treasurer's Report:** The treasurer's report was reviewed.

**Youth and Family Ministry:** Trisha Lambert stated that VBS was great. Everyone that wanted to attend was allowed. WOW will begin September 13th **Trustees Report:** The carpet replacement for the front steps has been ordered and a down payment put down. Replacing the carpeting on the back entry step will be at a later time.

**Elders Report:** Dave Titman and Carolyn Dirks stated that Homebound Communion is going well. They could still use more members willing to help out and give communion to those who wish it.

Stu Gerdes made a motion to accept the above reports as presented. Carolyn Dirks  $2^{nd}$ . Motion carried.

**Old Business:** The replacing of the carpeting at the entrances was old business and it was discussed during Trustees report.

**New Business:** DaLana Rigby said they would be working on getting ideas for the 2023 Benevolence Giving and present it at the next council meeting. They plan on keeping 5 of the same recipients that received last year. Marty Scharff reported to the council on the repairs to the organ. She's waiting for a breakdown and estimate of the repairs by priority. The repairs so far seem to be quite extensive. The organ was purchased around 1923. To replace it with a new one would run in the neighborhood of \$250,000. When Marty receives the paperwork, she will let the council know and it will be reviewed. Stu Gerdes brought up that people showed an interest in starting of the Sharing of the Peace again. It will begin on Sunday August 20<sup>th</sup>. People can either shake hands, bump elbows, greet however they fill comfortable. Stu Gerdes made a motion to adjourn and Carolyn Dirks 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion carried. Closed with the Lord's Prayer, The next meeting will be held Oct.8.


