A message from Pastor Dave...

On Sunday April 14th, we celebrated the confirmation of six young people. The theme for the day was: "If I Told You My Story 52 Years From Now." Fifty-two years ago - in 1972 - Rev. Naig was the pastor here at St. Matthew and twenty-three young people got confirmed that year. In 1972 over three-hundred people attending worship every Sunday. By comparison, we only have about sixty people at worship on any given Sunday, these days. The world has changed a lot in fifty-two years! I wonder what the world will be like 52 years from now, in 2076.

Fifty-two years ago - in 1972 - I got confirmed at St. Lukes Lutheran Church in Middleton, WI. On the day that I got confirmed, I never could have imagined that my life would turn out the way it has. In some ways it's been much better than I ever could have imagined; in some ways, much worse. Right now, take a moment to think about the best and worst days of your own life; then ponder how differently things have turned out compared to what you might have imagined when you were only fourteen years old.

During the Confirmation celebration I challenged those being confirmed to think about who they will be fifty-two years from now. I then told...

...them exactly what God expects from them during the next fifty-two years of their lives. Indeed, this is what God expects from each of us. The prophet Micah said. "This is what the Lord requires of you—seek justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with your God" (Micah 6:8).

As regards those who were confirmed this year, we hope and pray that, no matter where life takes them in the next fifty-two years, the seeds of faith planted during their years at WOW will be with them through thick and thin as their lives unfold. Below you'll find a few excerpts from the Faith Statements our confirmation students completed.

Confirmation Faith Statement Excerpts

During my time at WOW and Confirmation class I learned a lot. By attending worship so often my faith is stronger and I learned how to share the love of God with all people.

Confirmation and WOW have helped me better understand different kinds of people. I have learned that some people aren't very kind, caring or nice, but I should still do my best to be kind, caring, and patient with them.

One of my favorite memories of WOW is how Pastor Dave would dress up for Halloween, I loved his costumes!

I have grown in faith a lot because of WOW and Confirmation. When WOW first started I wasn't sure I was going to like it, but as the years went by I have learned many things about faith. As I got older, I lost a little bit of my faith, but going to confirmation helped me gain it back.

I have become closer to God since I've been going to church more, and I have a better understanding of the work of God and how to share the love of God.

I think God loves me because if he didn't he wouldn't have helped me through everything that I've been through. Jesus is the Lord of my life because He just is!

Being a person of faith means I always look for Jesus, not just when I need him the most, but all the time throughout my day. Faith helps me push forward through the daily struggles.

Confirmation Faith Statements Continued

During hard times, I pray to God to help me get through it, which I never used to do before. To share the love of God with all people, I show compassion and pray for others when I know they are struggling or just need a little happiness in their life.

I remember watching the video lessons during worship at WOW then talking about them after worship. We learned how to relate them to our own lives.

I do believe that God loves me and has called me by name to life in Christ. By going to WOW and Confirmation class, I know I can trust and depend on God when I need Him.

I try to be grateful, gracious, and generous. I'm not always like that, but I try. Sometimes I am greedy, grumpy, and grouchy, but everyone is like that sometimes. I try not to be that way.

Faith helps me through life by knowing I can pray to God and he will lead me through things and help me make good decisions. I get so much out of faith because I know I always have someone I can trust and talk to when I have no one else.

During my time in Confirmation I've learned that God loves me no matter what.

It means a lot for me to think of myself as a follower of Jesus Christ.

Our lives are a journey, a long haul with many peaks and valleys along the way. The fact is, those who have learned to trust and count on God are in a much better position to cope with whatever life throws at them. That's why we are a church! That's our mission—to grow in faith and share the love of God with all people, so they can learn to love and trust God!
