A Message From Pastor Dave...

Easter Sunday is on April 20th this year. Although the date of Easter changes every year, the good news that "He Is Risen!" never gets old and never goes out of style for those who long for life, and love, and immortality in Christ. After all, Easter is all about immortality, that is... life in Christ.

Therefore, I'd like to share with you two things: First, a quote from C.S. Lewis from his book, "The Weight of Glory," and then, a personal remembrance about my dad.

The Weight of Glory, C.S. Lewis

It is with awe and circumspection that we should conduct all our dealings with one another, all friendships, all loves, all play, even all politics. After all, there are no ordinary people. You have never talked to a mere mortal. Nations, cultures, and civilizations - these are mortal, and their life is to ours as the life of a gnat. But it is immortals whom we joke with, work with, marry, snub and exploit - immortal souls destine for either eternal torment or eternal bliss. This does not mean that we are to be perpetually solemn. We must play. But our merriment must be of that kind which exists between people who have, from the outset, taken each other seriously - no flippancy, no superiority, no presumption, no condescension, for we are all immortal.

In Memoriam: Remembering Dad

Twenty–four years ago, on March 15th 2001, my father died after a long and dreadful illness while I was in prison in Tennessee. I said good-bye to my dad, as he lay in a nursing home bed, on the morning I was sentenced to 20 years in prison. I never saw him again. Several months before my incarceration my dad lost both legs, just below the knee, to diabetes and he also suffered from debilitating arthritis. My dad saw me fall hard and go to prison, but he never got to see me serving as a pastor. Because of my incarceration, I was unable to attend his funeral so on Sunday March 2nd 2025, I dedicated our Holy Communion service to my dad, Ronald Dean Raemisch. Rest in Peace, Dad.


Lenten soup supper served every Wed. evening Mar. 5th to April 2nd.

Pastor's Report: We have only had two funerals at St. Matthew in the last 14 months (Don Monk & Mary Tschantz). Our Ash Wednesday service was cancelled due to weather (rescheduled for the following Wednesday). Jim Reuter and DaLana Rigby will lead worship on March 23^{rd.} Jim Reuter and Jeff Hinrichs will lead worship on Oct. 12th . New Members, Harold & Pat Knutsen recently joined St. Matthew. Welcome, we're glad you're here! **Treasurer's Report:** Thanks be to God, offerings for the first two months of 2025 exceeded expenses by \$3,101.16. We have \$54,898.68 in a Certificate of Deposit (4.35% interest) due to mature on November 7, 2025.

Building Treasurer's Report: The church insurance bill increased by \$2,809.00 this year. It now costs the church \$12,735.00 a year for insurance! **Education Board:** Pam Kray has completed her term of service; Thank You, Pam! We currently have no one serving on the Education Board.

Youth & Family Ministry: Vacation Bible School will be held in June. So far, we have been unable to find anyone interested in serving as the leader of our Youth & Family Ministry Program. At least for now, we hope to continue holding a worship service on Wednesday evenings next year, whether or not we find a new Youth Leader. A decision will be made later. WOW has declined over the last few years as Wednesday evening sports and dance programs in the area have expaned.

Trustees: St. Matthew has been consulted regarding renovation going on at Karde's Gas Station next to the church.

Deacons: Nothing new to report. **Elders:** We're currently serving homebound communion to twelve households. It's going well.

Lenten Soup Suppers: Special thanks to the women of WELCA for preparing and serving delicious Lenten soup suppers!

Outreach: A suggestion was made to build a Lil' Library and place it outside the church. DaLana & Jeff will follow-up.
