I also want to take this opportunity to sincerely thank each and every one of you who have supported our church financially. The cost of operating a church keeps going up, as witnessed by our \$13,000.00 insurance premium for 2025! That's over \$1,000.00 per month, just for insurance!

A few years ago, I sent out thank you cards to everyone that had made a financial contribution to St. Matthew during the preceding year. It was then that a strange thing happened. Some people who had made financial contributions to St. Matthew never got a thank you card in the mail, and wondered why I had skipped them.

Here's what happened. I went to the post office to buy some stamps, but they wouldn't let me use the church credit card because it had Stu's name on it. So, I went back to my office and ordered two rolls of stamps from Amazon. You can buy almost anything on Amazon these days, but this time it didn't go as planned.

A few days after I mailed out those thank you cards, I got a phone call from the U.S. Post Master in the quad-cities informing me that they had confiscated some of my thank you cards, because the stamps that I'd used were counterfeit!

So now you know "the rest of the story." If you never received a card from me, thanking you for your financial support of our church, it's because the post office confiscated your card.

Regardless, you'll see in the financial statement that appears later in this newsletter that we're doing pretty good keeping up with our bills. Thank you for your generous support of ministry here at St. Matthew!


